STUDENT ACCOUNT

Eligibility

- Aged 18 or above
- UK resident for at least the last 3 years
- No student account elsewhere
- Full time qualifying course at a UK university

Proof of College Acceptance

- Proof of unconditional acceptance
- E.g. UCAS letter or letter from your university

Proof of Identity + Address

- E.g. current passport + visa, valid identity card
- Letter from university
- UK Correspondence Address

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ACCOUNT

Eligibility

- Aged 18 or above
- Studying in the UK for 2+ years

Proof of Identity (any one)

- Full and current passport
- Current photocard driving licence
- A non-UK national photo ID card

Proof of Address

- UK bank statement
- Utility bill
- Proof of student status



STANDARD CURRENT ACCOUNT

Proof of Identity

CLASSIC ACCOUNT

Eligibility

• Aged 18 or above

Documents Required

- Current passport and visa (if needed)
- Enrolment letter

STUDENT ACCOUNT

Eligibility

- Aged 17 or above
- UK resident for at least 3 years
- Full time qualifying course at a UK university

APPLYING FOR A VISA

The earliest you can apply for a visa is **three months** before the start of your course. It costs £335 to apply for a visa outside the UK.

DOCUMENTS YOU MUST PROVIDE:

- a current passport or other valid travel documentation
- proof that you can support yourself and pay for your course this will vary depending on your circumstances
- proof of parental or legal guardian consent if you're under 18
- proof of your relationship with your parent or guardian
- your tuberculosis test results if you're from a country where you have to take the test

APPLYING OUTSIDE THE UK:

- Apply online: Tier 4 (General) student visa
- Visit the visa application centre to have your fingerprints and photo taken
- Receive your documents by collection or post, visa application processing usually takes within 10 days
- Check if 'Pol Reg' appears on your visa, if it does, you will have to register with the police within seven days of entering the UK
- Collect your Biometric Residences Permit at the place you selected, which for most of you would be UCL

TUBERCULOSIS TEST:

- Make an appointment in one of the approved test clinics
- Make sure you bring
 - proof of identification, which contains your photograph, such as your passport
 - the tuberculosis test fee
 - details of your previous screening and if possible, your medical notes and x-ray results only if you have had tuberculosis in the past or have any other lung disease

REGISTERING WITH THE POLICE

If you need to register, you must go to the police within 7 days of arriving in the UK.

- COMPLETE THE OCR REGISTRATION PROFORMA FOUND ONLINE.
- VISIT THE OVERSEAS VISITORS RECORD OFFICE.

 Submit the following documents and pay the £34 registration fee:
 - 2 recent passport size colour photographs
 - Your passport
 - Your visa 'vignette' (sticker in your passport), if you applied outside the UK
 - The letter you got from the Home Office when your application was approved, if you applied inside the UK
 - Your Biometric Residences Permit
- AFTER YOU REGISTER: KEEP THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE WHILE YOUR VISA LASTS.

Keep the registration certificate so you can:

- Prove that you've registered with the police
- Tell the police if your details have changed
- Return to the UK if you travel
- Apply for a longer stay in the UK

ENROLMENT

Steps on how to pre-enrol, enrol and pay for tuition.

Pre-Enrolment

- UCL will send an invitation to pre-enrol within six weeks of the start of term.
- Step 1: Online user registration to obtain your UCL user ID and set up your password.
- Step 2: Pre-enrolment task on Portico

Quickest and easiest way to pay



Bank Transfer

Instruct your bank or pay via online banking, bank details on the UCL website

Enrolment

- After pre-enrolling, you will be sent an email telling you where and when to enrol.
- Important documents:
 - o Copy of your offer letter
 - o Photographic identification
 - Visa (if necessary)
 - o Biometric Residences Permit (if necessary)
 - o ATAS Certificate (if your course requires it)
- You must also know or have access to your Student Number.



Cheque

Payable to 'University College London', posted to UCL student fees or in person to Student Centre 2



Cash

Can be paid directly to Barclays Bank, accompanied by an invoice

MOBILE

There are many mobile telephone networks and plans you can use: 3, giffgaff, O2, Vodafone etc. Here are the plans for two of the networks.



PAY AS YOU GO

£25 per month: unlimited data + 500 mins

£20 per month: 12GB data + 300 mins £10 per month: 1GB4 data + 100 mins

PAY PER MONTH - 12 month contract

£19 per month: 30GB data + 600 mins £15 per month: 8GB data + 600 mins £12 per month: 4GB data + all-youcan-eat minutes

"Feel at Home" feature means you can use your SIM card in 60 destinations to call and text the UK and use data at no extra cost.

giffgaff

PAY AS YOU GO

£20 per month: 6GB data + unlimited mins £18 per month: 6GB data + 2000 mins £15 per month: 5GB data + 1000 mins

As a giffgaff member, you enjoy free giffgaff calls and texts. This means you can call, text, or video call for free to anyone with a giffgaff number!

HOW MUCH WIFI DO YOU NEED?



A free wireless service called eduroam is available throughout UCL Campus and Halls. So unless you're interested in data heavy services, you don't need that much data!
